Opening Sentences

Examples...

The boy ate pizza.



My goodness, the boy ate pizza! **exclamatory (!)**

Eating the pizza, the boy was sick. **verb**

Hungrily, the boy ate the pizza. **adverb**

"That's yummy," he said, eating the pizza. **speech ""**

The pizza was eaten by the boy. **passive**

Do you know what he ate? Pizza! **question**



Opening Sentences
