The boy ate pizza.







Examples...





My goodness, the boy ate pizza! exclamatory (!)

Eating the pizza, the boy was sick. **Verb** 

Hungrily, the boy ate the pizza. adverb

"That's yummy," he said, eating the pizza. Speech ""

The pizza was eaten by the boy. **Passive** 

Do you know what he ate? Pizza! **Question**

speech ""

"Please feed me!" he said hungrily.

exclamatory (!)

(1) He was absolutely starving!

question

When is lunch? he wanted to know.

verb

Rumbling, his tummy told him he was hungry.

adverb

Miserably hungry, he just wanted to eat.

passive

He was made hungry by not eating enough.
