Possession

These have **do have an** apostrophe:

Eg: This is Kci's pencils.

Is it Pine's turn for lunch?

This book is Kacper's.

Contraction

When we shorten words, we use an apostrophe in place of the missing letters.

Eg: can not = can't

Will not = won't

Should not = shouldn't

You are = you're

I will = I'll

Plurals (more than 1)

These have **No** apostrophe:

Eg: I have lots of pencils.

The cars on the road are noisy.

He went shopping with his family, including his brothers and sisters.
