$2 + 7 = 12$ 3

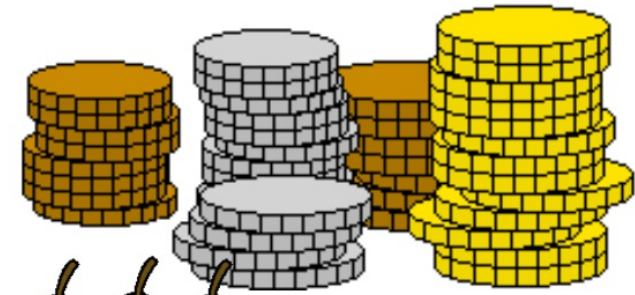
$18 - 7 = 4$ 8

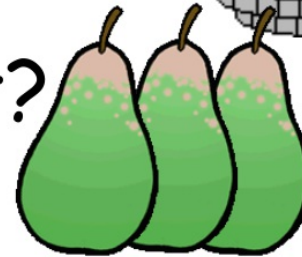



One pear costs 10p. 

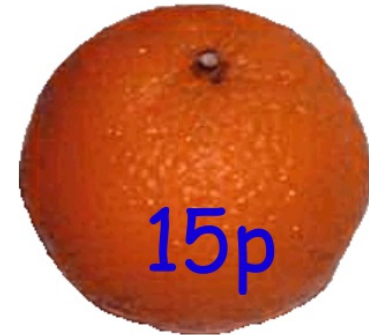


How much do 3 pears cost?

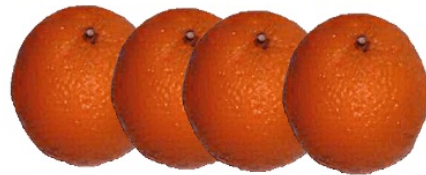


If I buy a multipack of 3 pears, it costs 25p. How much do I save?
