
The following pages show line drawings of fruit. Notice how the artist has used heavy and lighter lines to show the difference in light.



This style is simpler. There is no heavy or lighter pencil use, but the artist is careful where to put the lines to show shadow.








Take a piece of plastic fruit or vegetable.
